In consideration of the mutual benefits stated in this contract, Lessor and Lessee agree to the following terms and conditions:

Lessee shall pay \$10.00, to be **submitted along with the signed contract at least 1 week prior to event.** Make check payable to Pinconning & Linwood Area Chamber of Commerce. *PLEASE NOTE:* Less than 1 week in advance or "day of event" cost will be \$25.00 per space.

- 1. Lessee agrees that Lessor shall retain the entire fee paid, if for whatever reason, Lessee is unable to participate in this event, including, but not limited to, instances of inclement weather. There are **NO Refunds.**
- 2. Priority in location of leased space shall be given to those Vendors in the order that they **return signed** contract with fee including a certificate of liability insurance.
- 3. Lessee agrees that this contract is only for the lease of space and that Lessee is acting completely independent of Lessor and not as an employee, partner, or agent of Lessor, and as such assumes all responsibility for withholding taxes, Social Security, state taxes, public liability, and Workers' Compensation insurance and also assumes responsibility for insurance coverage to, from, and during the Pumpkin Festival and for accident or injury to Lessee, Lessee's employees or agents and Lessee's equipment.

- 4. The following item(s) is (are) to be sold and is (are) the only item(s) authorized for this booth and any additional items must be approved in writing by Lessor:
- 5. **Merchandise/Product:** Promoter/Lessor reserves the right to prohibit the exhibit and/or sale of items that are not in keeping with the family nature of the event. Similarly, no unethical or unlawful practice will be tolerated.
 - a. Literature, merchandise, etc. cannot be sold outside of your booth/concession and may only be given away outside your booth if you receive approval and pay additional required fees.
 - b. No sound amplification or equipment may be used in your booth unless approved.
 - c. Each Vendor shall be responsible for the cleanliness of its site and shall remove and properly dispose of all rubbish, trash, and discarded materials.
 - d. No raffle or drawing is allowed that is not previously approved by Promoter/Lessor, including those where the intent of the Vendor is to make all chances free and without obligation.
 - e. All persons, companies, or organizations renting booth/concession space do so an independent contractor and not as an employee or agent of the festival or its management or Promoter/Lessor herein.
- 6. Lessor <u>may</u> be able to provide the specified electrical requirements with advance notice from the vendor, but it is not guaranteed. If requested, Lessor will advise vendor if it is not available.
- 7. **Security:** Lessor assumes no responsibility for the safety and security of Lessee's property and Lessee agrees to hold Lessor harmless. Security is not provided. Do NOT leave small valuables in the park. We have been very fortunate that we have had very little problems, but if it is something that someone can walk away with, please keep it in sight. All exhibitor and vendor booths shall have at least one person in the booth at all times. If you are running a booth alone, please arrange for a neighbor vendor to cover your booth if you need to step away.
- 8. **Set-up/Tear-down:** Saturday, October 11, 2025, set up by 10:45 AM. No Vendor or Exhibitor shall exceed the allocated space per booth. Standard frontage will be approximately 10' to 10'. Removal of your booth and supplies must be completed no later than 6:00 PM, Saturday, October 11, 2025.
- 9. **Crafter/Vendor Hours of Operation:** Saturday, October 11, 2025, from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. If you want to stay open beyond 3:00 PM, you are free to do so.
- 10. Parking: No vehicles are allowed in your rental space. Once unloaded, park your vehicles in designated parking areas. Booth deliveries or tear-down during festival hours can ONLY be made with hand trucks or golf cart-type which are not provided by Lessor. No vehicles are allowed during festival hours due to safety concerns.
- 11. Waiver & Release Of Liability: In consideration of my entry acceptance, admission to and/or participation in the 2025 Pinconning & Linwood Chamber of Commerce Pumpkin Festival and its related events, I for myself and anyone acting on my behalf, release, waive, discharge, covenant not to sue and agree to hold The Pinconning & Linwood Chamber of Commerce or its Pumpkin Festival sponsors, the City of Pinconning, participating clubs, communities and organizations, emergency and support personnel, volunteers and their representative harmless from any and all claims, demands and actions of any and every kind I have, may have or may hereafter accrue against the released parties directly or

indirectly arising out of or relating in any respect to my attending or participating in the Pumpkin Festival and its related events. With submission of this agreement vendor accepts responsibility for any required licenses and to keep them in full force and in effect through the duration of the Pumpkin Festival. Lessor assumes no responsibility for the safety and security of Lessee's property and Lessee agrees to hold Lessor harmless.

- 12. - 15. This contract is subject to the laws of the State of Michigan and the proper venue for any legal actions shall be in Bay County, Michigan.
